What Does a Dollar Do in Wright County? (2026 Impact)

Every dollar matters—and together, they go even further.

\$10–\$30

Provides 2 nutritious meals for homebound seniors
Supplies a weekend food backpack for a local child

\$60

Provides a week of gas assistance for someone in crisis
Supplies 4–5 food backpacks for children in need

\$90

Provides weekly breakfast for 2-3 children in need focusing on budget friendly plans
Focusing on staples like eggs, oatmeal, and seasonal fruit

\$125

Provides safe shelter for a family for three nights
Provides a new, safe car seat for a child in need.

\$300

Supports community wellness programs
Funds health check-ins for seniors

\$750 - \$1,000

Helps cover monthly childcare for a family
Provides school-based mental health support
